

## Training lawyers for Europe: The Academy of European Law





- ERA and ECBA have cooperated in training events since the year 2010 when we handed-in our first joint project titled ,European Criminal Law for Defence Counsel' under a call for proposals of the European Commission
- The 2010 project run over 2 years with 6 seminars for in total 150 defence lawyers from all over the EU
- In 2012, we applied again for such a training and in 2013 and 2014, we offered 5 seminars on European criminal law to ca. 150 defence lawyers from all EU Member States.
- A third series was won in 2014 and we are conducting 4 seminars with ca. 120 defence lawyers this year. The last one will take place in Budapest from 9-10 October 2015.



- In summary, ECBA and ERA conducted in this seminar series' 15 seminars for 420 defence lawyers from all EU Member States!
- All seminars
  - consisted of lectures and workshops looking at cross-border cases
  - offered different language regimes
  - offered the opportunity to network.
- Furthermore, a public internet portal was set-up on the ERA website in EN, DE, FR, and ES where all presentations and relevant legal texts are accessible to everyone interested

# ERA Academy of European Law

- The ECBA supported all events with:
  - Advice on programme and speakers
  - Marketing in the Member States
  - Publishing the project on the websites

- In all events, the ECBA was presented
  - through its speakers
  - with its logo on the programmes as well as on the respective pages on the ERA website



- Another project where the ECBA and ERA cooperated in last years offered
  - 6 seminars in EN, FR, DE
  - on the role of the European Court of Justice in criminal matters
  - A speciality of these events is that they bring together judges, prosecutors, and defence lawyers.



- Under the current call for proposals of the European Commission (deadline 16.11.2015), the ECBA and ERA will apply for the following two projects:
- 1. Procedural safeguards in the EU
  - 4 conferences on the different measures of the EU roadmap on procedural safeguards,
  - each time addressed to varying target groups: defence lawyers, judges, prosecutors, law enforcement, interpreters and translators etc.
- 2. The life cycle of the electronic evidence in criminal proceedings
  - simulations and live demonstrations for judges, prosecutors and defence lawyers from all EU Member States
  - 6 seminars in different EU cities



- Cross-border defence in the EU Local Approach
  - Finally, to attract a wider group of defence lawyers, the ECBA and ERA will cooperate in a new training project for defence lawyers on a local level. The project is financed by ERA and the respective local partners and consists of
    - 1-day training events at the local level in the local language
    - The core of the trainings will be case studies on cross-border cooperation in criminal matters in the EU.
    - There will be 1-2 local experts + one guest speaker to present the cooperation with another EU Member State.
